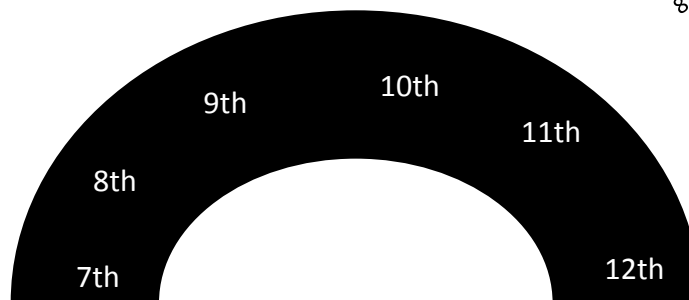


Homecoming Float Rules Sponsor Instructions

- 10' x 10' wooden float frame- NO LARGER! You must build your theme onto your float/board.
- Each class can spend up to \$150.00 on supplies for your float design.
- Each class must follow the theme picked by the Student Council. The 12th grade will pick first, followed by the 11th grade and so on.
- If you need to repair your float board – the sponsor of the class must be the one to make the decisions. The funds will be taken out of your class accounts.
- Classes are allowed to begin working on their float the weekend before Homecoming -NO EARLIER!
- ALL WORK must be done by the students. Parents are **not** to work on the floats. This is an opportunity for the students to make memories as a class. It is not fair to the other classes when parents do the work.
- Each sponsor is responsible for the floats, workers, repairs (if needed), and supplies. You are welcome to get the tax-exempt Wal-Mart card from the office and use it to purchase supplies (you will then reimburse the school with a check from your class fund).
- It is up to the sponsors to arrange getting the float to and from the school and setting the place and time(s) to work on decorating it. The board MUST be removed from the school on Monday after Homecoming.
 - SENIOR SPONSOR: Each senior class hands their board down to the current 6th grade class (next year's 7th grade class). Please make sure before Homecoming Day that you have a 6th grade parent lined up to pick up the board no later than the Monday after Homecoming.
- Floats must be completely ready by 11:30 the morning of Homecoming. Your class MUST clean up the area around the float as soon as it is complete.
- You may add 3-D items to your float if these items are made by the students. (i.e. You may NOT have a real car/vehicle/trailer or other large items brought in to park besides, under, or around the board). The scene must be made by the students using the materials purchased for the float. These items must be attached securely to the board.
- The floats are placed on the grassy circle outside the elementary back door. The order is as follows:
